### Dalata Hotel Group

Dalata Hotel Group was founded in 2007 by former chief executive of Jurys Doyle Hotel Group Pat McCann. It operates 40 hotels across the UK and Ireland with a total of 6,729 rooms and 4,366 employees.

In March 2014, Dalata Hotel Group floated on the AIM market of the London Stock Exchange and the ESM market of the Irish stock exchange, raising equity of ?265m with debt of ?282m. At the beginning of 2015, the company acquired nine properties in the UK and Ireland which were part of Moran Bewley's Hotel Group, in a deal worth ?452.3m. Dalata Hotel Group also acquired an additional eight hotels in Ireland. In September the group raised ?160m for further expansion through equity fundraising and in October announced the purchase of the freehold interest in the Clarion Hotel Cork for ?35.1m. Since January 1st this year, the Group announced the acquisition of the Clarion Hotel Sligo and the conditional acquisition of the leasehold interest in the Gibson Hotel Dublin, the Croydon Park Hotel in Croydon, the Clarion Hotel Cork and the Clarion Hotel Limerick. Most recently the Group acquired a site in Dublin 2, which has planning permission for a 181 bedroom 4 star hotel.
